



#### Darrell Bock:

"We know little about the rest of the group: Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolaus. All the names are Greek, underscoring the potential and likely Hellenist roots of the group, although by this time such names were common among Jews of Judea. Most of the names in question here are not commonly used in Judaism..."

## Solution:

- 1. Bring *Unity*
- 2. *Pluralize* Hebraic control and leadership
- 3. Get the right **sort** of Hellenist
