Acts 26

Trans:

"There is no way this is right! You're crazy!

Then Agrippa said to Paul, "Do you think that in such a short time you can persuade me to be a Christian?"

Trans:

Do you really think you're going to get me to accept this? There are a lot of other issues here.

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Acts 26:25

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"Irrational" meaning: Inconceivable? (a self-contradiction)

Examples:

Bill is a married bachelor 2+2=9

The rabbit is a vegetable Sarah draws a square circle

"Irrational" meaning: Extremely improbable

"100% of humans that die stay dead. So Jesus rising is just unbelievable."

Circular reasoning...



Humans don't rise, so Jesus could not have risen. Jesus didn't rise, so He isn't God.

"Humans that are not also God, that are not acted upon by any divine outside force stay dear 100% of the time."






Can a knife be pliers? yes, if...

Facts About the Resurrection:

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REASONABLE

"I have a good life. I'm not letting this hijack it."

Then Agrippa said to Paul, "Do you think that in such a short time you can persuade me to be a Christian?"

Translation into "pragmatic":

"Do you think I'm going to give up my control, freedom, credibility and respectability for this?

Paul replied, "Short time or long — I pray to God that not only you but all who are listening to me today may become what I am, except for these chains."

Translation:

"Hiding behind time is a stall tactic motivated by fear and pride. If it's true, it's true. Time, nor consequences, have anything to do with it."
