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2 steps in really embracing stewardship:


1. Lay everything down

ESV 1 Corinthians 4:2 ...it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.

That is: Faithfulness

Paith - you know the master is the master
 Paithfulness - a steward invests with the master's intentions in mind.



A few examples in the New Testament:

Romans 16:23 "Erastus, the city steward"- translated "treasurer"

ESV 1 Corinthians 4:1 This is how one should regard us (ministry leaders), as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

ESV **Titus 1:7-8** For an **overseer**, as God's **steward**, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined."

Some translations are removing the word:

NIV 1 Corinthians 4:2 Now it is required that [those who have been given a trust] must prove faithful.

ESV 1 Corinthians 4:2 Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.

Jesus the Steward

Jesus] was faithful to the one who appointed him just as Moses was faithful in all God's house. Jesus has been found worthy of greater honor than Moses, just as the builder of a house has greater honor than the house itself. For every house is built by someone, but God is the builder of everything. Moses was faithful as a servant in all God's house, testifying to what would be said in the future.

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



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
