

Moral Gravity is the only immunity to the dangers of splendor

Shame is the compassionate treatment for lewdness.

Extravagant generosity is innerently clangerous (EOUS)

Ezekiel 16:13 – 15

"You became very beautiful and rose to be a queen. And your fame spread among the nations on account of your beauty, because the splendor I had given you made your beauty perfect," declares the Sovereign LORD.

Ezekiel 16:13 – 15

"...the splendor I had given you made your beauty perfect," declares the Sovereign LORD. "But you trusted in your beauty and used your fame to become a prostitute. You lavished your favors on anyone who passed by and your beauty became his."

Descent into Lewdness

Lust – disordered desire Moral Amnesia – convenient forgetting Idolatry – making new gods Lewdness – betrayal is a public virtue Devouring - objectifying everything

Only 2 outcomes:

Consumption – the devouring will end

Shame – facing the horror

2. Confrontation makes restoration possible

(intervention and consequences are a shock cocktail)

Isn't shame bad?

There are at least 3 kinds of shame. And keeping them distinct is CRITICAL.

Psychological

Shame as self-hatred

"My flaws make me unworthy of love, belonging, or connection."

Remedy: Self-compassion and vulnerability with empathetic people.

Social/Cultural

Shame as opposite of honor

"Deserved, proportionate moral approbation for failing to act justly and responsibly"

Remedy: restitution and recovery

Moral/Spiritual

Shame as the opposite of Lewdness

"The recovery of moral sensitivity to the social costs of selfish and idolatrous behavior" (You not having empathy for others)

Remedy: SHAME IS THE REMEDY.

Shame's reversal of lewdness

- 1. Devouring feeling the pain yourself
- 2. Memory "coming to yourself" (Luke 15)
- 3. Realization rewriting false memories
- 4. Shame and humiliation

5. Rehabilitation and restoration to Grace

6. Remarriage and re-adornment

Memory, shame and splendor

- Our safety in the splendor of glorification is in the solidity of our moral gravity
- Memory of our spiritual immune system

"You did not remember"

"You will remember"

Ezekiel 20:43 - 44

"There you will remember your conduct and all the actions by which you have defiled yourselves, and you will loathe yourselves for all the evil you have done. You will know that I am the LORD..."

"You will remember"

Ezekiel 36:31 - 36

"Then you will remember your evil ways and wicked deeds, and you will loathe yourselves for your sins and detestable practices. I want you to know that I am not doing this for your sake," declares the Sovereign LORD.

I will remember

Ezekiel 16:60 - 63

"Yet I will remember the covenant I made with you in the days of your youth, and I will establish an everlasting covenant with you. Then you will remember your ways and be ashamed when you receive your sisters, both those who are older than you and those who are younger...

I will remember

"...I will give them to you as daughters, but not on the basis of my covenant with you. So I will establish my covenant with you, and you will know that I am the LORD. Then, when I make atonement for you for all you have done, you will remember and be ashamed and never again open your mouth because of your humiliation," declares the Sovereign LORD.

Luke 22:18 - 20

"For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you."
