

#### When tradition tears:

- 1. Family is "super hard"
- 2. I've already screwed up
- 3. Broken families all around me
- 4. I'm single—the other gender doesn't seem to be serious.
- 5. Engaged couples: "I'm going to do this. Help!?"
- 6. None of my married friends are happy.
- 7. Is marriage really necessary?
- 8. "Family" like you're defining it is just a construct—one that is a harmful fiction.
- 9. Securing happiness requires what Jesus rejects.
- 10. Why is this such a big deal?

#### What do we do now?

#### **Two Options:**

- 1. Invent a new technique
- 2. Return to an original purpose.

#### Matthew 19:3-9

Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?"

4 "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' 5 and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? 6 So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate." 7 "Why then," they asked, "did Moses command that a man give his wife a certificate of divorce and send her away?" 8 Jesus replied, "Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. 9 I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery."

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
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
1. Family is a creation not a construct

#### 4 "one flesh" horizons:

- 1. The woman came out of the man creation
- 2. Man and woman in marriage covenant/union

#### Genesis 3-5: Breakdown

#### **Genesis 2:21-25**

So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, he took one of the man's ribs and closed up the place with flesh. Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man. The man said, "This is *now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh*; she shall be called 'woman', for she was taken out of man." For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will *become one flesh*. The man and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.

# 4 "one flesh" horizons:

- 1. The woman came out of the man creation
- 2. Man and woman in marriage covenant/union
- 3. Man and woman in children fruitfulness
- 4. The son of man made flesh the incarnation ('seed of the woman...' Gen 3:15)

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#### "...it was not this way from the beginning..."

#### Therefore:

- 1. Gender complementarity is utterly fundamental
- 2. If family is an attacked and broken institution because it is a divine institution
- 3. You can honor God by not getting married

- 4. Broken family? Creation ideal + redemptive angle
- 5. Other options? um...

#### Matthew 19:9-12

I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, and marries another woman commits adultery." The disciples said to him, "If this is the situation between a husband and wife, it is better not to marry."

Jesus replied, "Not everyone can accept this word, but only those to whom it has been given. For some are **eunuchs** because they were **born that way**; others were **made that way** by men; and others have renounced marriage because of the kingdom of heaven. The one who can accept this should accept it."

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# 1. Family is a creation not a construct

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#### Reflecting the kingdom through creation:

- Gender represents complementarity and diversity between us and in God.
- Marriage reflects Christ and the church.
- Covenant represents the tenacity of God's commitment.
- Parenting reflects our relation to God love, authority and superiority.
- Children represent the gift of giving life, provision, delighting in another, acceptance of responsibility, the expandability of life, etc.
- Provision of husband represents "a place prepared for us."

# 2. Family reflects the kingdom (as creation)

#### Therefore: Misuse of creation tells lies about the kingdom.

- -Sex outside of covenant "represents a Christ who uses the church without joining her, covenantally, to himself"
- -Children treated as expenses, abused, ignored or abandoned teach that God ignores, abuses, abandons and sees us as an inconvenience.
- -Divorce reflects the limits of God's longsuffering nature.
- -Unhappy marriages say holiness doesn't bring happiness.
- -Gender, delayed commitment, etc...

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
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
