2 PETER 1:3-11 // NIV 1984

For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But if anyone does not have them, he is nearsighted and blind, and has forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins.

Therefore, my brothers, be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fall, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Jeremiah 2:13-14

"My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water. Is Israel a servant, a slave by birth? Why then has he become plunder?"

Luke: Fighting for Joy with the Gospel

Luke 2:10-11 (to the shepherds)

...the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord."

Luke's "Infancy Narratives"

- the angel coming to Zachariah and Elizabeth becoming pregnant and bearing John the Baptist
- the angel Gabriel going to Nazareth and speaking to Mary about becoming pregnant with Jesus
- Mary visiting Elizabeth, and Mary's song
- the birth of John the Baptist and Zachariah's song
- the trek of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem
- the birth of Jesus in a manger because there was no room in the inn
- shepherds in the field at night seeing the great host of angels singing about the glory of God
- and the only story of Jesus as a boy when he stayed behind in the temple speaking to the religious teachers in his father's house

The Glory of God is revealed in Jesus for the joy of all people.

Luke 2:19

But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart.

Luke 2:51

Then he went down to Nazareth with them and was obedient to them. But his mother treasured all these things in her heart.

So why does the gospel start with these very formal first four verses?

The Good News rests on certain testimony.

or

The testimony about Jesus is solid as a rock.

1. News rests on testimony

Speech

- Personal expertise
- Coherent message
- intuitive appeal
- relevant and useful
- promising if done
- useful
- verifiable through practice

News

- personally witnessed
- thoroughly investigated
- truthful testimony

(since it is an unrepeatable event)

2. The Gospel rests on abundant and credible testimony

15 references to credible and abundant testimony:

Luke 1:1-4

Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. Therefore, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, it seemed good also to me to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

3. The goal is credible certainty of the truth

verse 1 "...things that have been fulfilled among us."

verse 2 "...servants of the word."

verse 4 "...the certainty of the things you have been taught."
