1. Jesus is here to gather, not send away. He's not trying to send you away, he's trying to bring you along.

Luke 5·27-32

Luke 5:12-16

"Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean."

Jesus REACHED OUT and TOUCHED the man "I am willing. Be clean."

2. Jesus is willing to cleanse.

Divine willingness is not the obstacle to your true healing.

Luke 5:17-26 "Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

"So that you will know the son of man has authority to forgive sins."

3. Jesus' primary cleansing is the forgiveness of sins.

Forgiveness is the backstop cleansing that brings real healing.

Luke 5:27-32
