3. Stewardship is a role, not a standing. Slaves that are sons, and friends.


4. Stewardship is your identity in Christ.






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

Convictionally embrace the identity and mindset of a steward

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


1 Thessalonians 2:2-5

We had previously suffered and been insulted in Philippi, as you know, but with the help of our God we dared to tell you his gospel in spite of strong opposition. For the appeal we make does not spring from error or impure motives, nor are we trying to trick you. On the contrary, we speak as men approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please men but God, who tests our hearts. You know we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed—God is our witness.
