Bean/Pea



Mustard plant



Multiplication factor

Multiplication factor:

Chick Pea:

Seed 1/2 (4/8) in x 72 in (6ft) adult plant

= 144 multiplier

Mustard Plant:

Seed 1/8 in

x 156 in (13ft) tall

= 1248 multiplier

(and a mustard plant is **MUCH** wider.

So the multiplier could actually be 4x this amount)



Yeast

"Active Dry Yeast" is almost all "medium" and only a tiny amount actual yeast.
