




The Faith:

Do they cause you to feel dismissive, fearful, CUIOUSS

EXAMPLE: 2 "THIEVES"

Mark 15:27,32

Matthew 27:38,44

Luke 23:39-43

2 thieves, both insulted him

2 thieves, both cast insults on him

one insults him, the other asks for salvation

Objections: Thieves weren't ever crucified by Romans, and this is inconsistent!

Except that thieves WERE crucified by Romans:

THE THEVES WEREN'T THEVES

Modern translations: "Robbers"

GREEK HAS THREE WORDS FOR "THIEF" kleptes—common word for stealing arpage—seizure of posessions (often through technically legal means) Matt 23:25, Luke 11:39 lestes—"plunder or piracy" robbery through force and violence "brigand, pirate, bandit, highwayman" etc.
