Romanticism: "To find yourself



God wants you to experience the power

of seeing his glory

in the pattern of Christ.

(a pre-requisite for 'finding yourself')

1. God wants the eyes of our heart to see his glory

Ephesians 1:17-19a "I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe."

4 things God wants you to "know":

- 1. God himself
- 2. The hope to which he has called you
- 3. The riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints
- 4. His incomparably great power for those that believe.

2. We can see his glorious exertion of power in Christ

Ephesians 1:19b-21 That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

God's power exerted in Christ

Displayed in power of what's done:

- 1. Overcame death
- 2. Seated in heaven
- 3. Over everything
- 4. Forever

Veiled in weakness of the story:

- 1. He died terribly
- 2. Blessing are "in heaven"
- 3. His rule isn't recognized
- 4. Forever isn't here yet

If you don't understand God's revelation of Glory "in Christ", you won't understand it at all.

3. We are with him and he is with us in that power.

Ephesians 1:22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

Hebrews 10:11-14

Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, because by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made
