The mystery of God's grace is a multiethnic church. At the appropriate time in history, God sent his son Jesus into the world to condemn all peoples of sin and reconcile all peoples to himself not by making Gentiles, Jews or making Jews, Gentiles but by making a new people in his own spiritual image. This is what Paul calls the mystery.
