






EPHESICARIS 4:17-21







Ephesians 4:17 – 18

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts.

Ephesians 4:19 – 21 Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed. That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus.

 Avoid "the light" of the truth because I don't want to feel guilt


 I can know 10,000 things and still be ignorant

- It is a self-imposed separation because God's grace is available

- Gratification of the body or the ego become paramount

Applications


- Be all in.
