Joy in Philippians

- Paul prays for the Philippian believers with joy because of their partnership with him in the gospel. (1:4-5)
- He rejoices that Christ is proclaimed—even when Christ is proclaimed for the sake of stirring up trouble for Paul. (1:17-18)
- He rejoices that his current hardship will turn out for his deliverance, through the prayers of the believers and the help of the Spirit. (1:18-
- through the prayers of the believers and the help of the Spirit. (1:18-1:19)
 Paul is convinced that the continuation of his ministry to the Philippians will contribute to their "progress and joy in the faith". (1:25)
- Paul has joy when the believers are unified and single-minded. (2:2)
- Paul would be glad in his sacrifice for the sake of their faith, so that his ministry was not in vain. (2:17)
