

TAKE HOPE AND COURAGE KNOWING THE DEAD IN CHRIST WILL RISE.

1. THE DEAD IN CHRIST WILL RISE LIKE CHRIST

1 Thessalonians 4:14

For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him.

CHRIST'S RESURRECTION

Acts 2:23 - 24

"...you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.

TIED TO JESUS

1 Thessalonians 4:14

For we believe that <u>Jesus</u> died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring <u>with</u> <u>Jesus</u> those who have fallen asleep <u>in him</u>.

Rom 8:11, 1 Cor 6:14, 2 Cor 4:14

THE CONDITIONAL CREED

1 Thessalonians 4:14

For *if* we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus.

CONDITIONAL CRED

2 Timothy 2:11 — 13 NIV "Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; if we are faithless, he remains faithful, for he cannot disown himself.


4 COURAGE PRODUCING HOPES:
