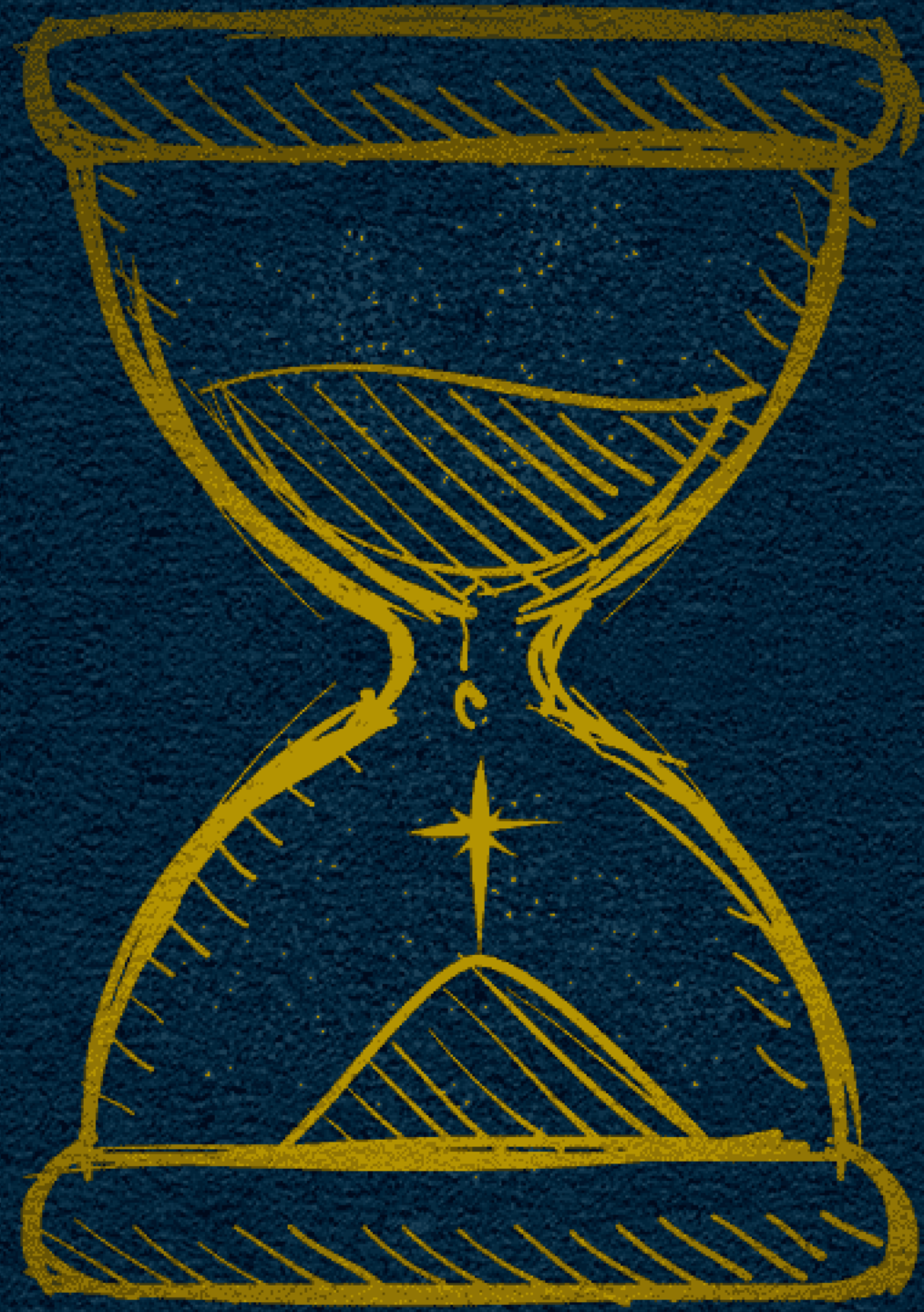

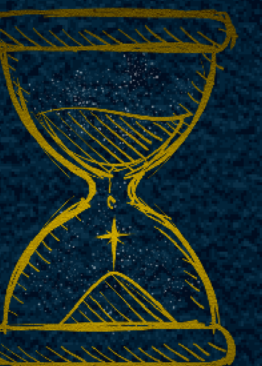


The Classroom of Waiting

The **BASIS** of our hope is Christ, his cross and resurrection.

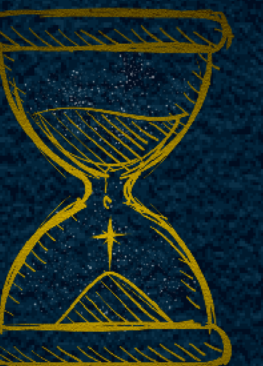
The **OBJECT** of our hope is God and his perfect plan.

*So what is the **ACTIVITY** of our hope?*



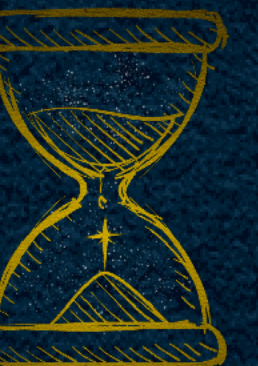
Ephesians 2:10

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.



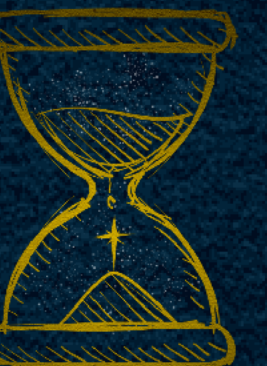
Romans 8:18

I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.



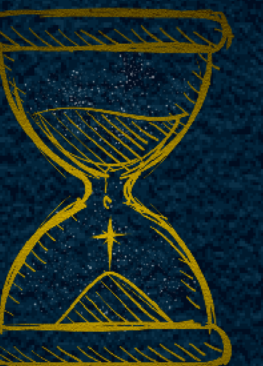
2 Timothy 2:11 – 13
