#### 1. WARNINGS CANIMAKE A DIFFERENCE ...RARELY


#### EZEKIEL 3:18


#### WATCHMAN VS. SAVIOR

saving. The warned person must take responsibility to act.





# 3. AWARNING IS A DELIVERY, NOT A DEFENSE.

#### EZEKIEL 3:26-27

I will make your tongue stick to the roof of your mouth so that you will be *silent and unable to rebuke them*, [for] they are a rebellious house. But when I speak to you, I will open your mouth and you shall say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says.' Whoever will listen let him listen, and whoever will refuse let him refuse; for they are a rebellious house.
