



1. God's salvation is the complete remedy to our depravity

Presumption: "I'm good."

Ezekiel 11:15 "Son of man, your brothers, even your brothers, your kinsmen, the whole house of Israel, all of them, are those of whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have said, 'Go far from the LORD; to us this land is given for a possession.'



Ezekiel 11:18-21

"They will return to it and remove all its vile images and detestable idols. I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh. Depravity

"The state of profound moral corruption."

- 2. A divided "go after" heart
- 3. A sick spirit and stone heart
- 4. An unjust, pragmatic will
- 5. Unfitness to know God

Care

Ezekiel 11:16-17

Therefore say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Although I sent them far away...yet for a little while I have been a sanctuary for them...where they have gone.'"Therefore say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will gather you from the nations and bring you back from the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give you back the land of Israel again.'

Undivided heart and a New Spirit

Ezekiel 11:19

Ezekiel 11:22–25 Then the cherubim, with the wheels beside them, spread their wings, and the glory of the God of Israel was above them. The glory of the LORD went up from within the city and stopped above the mountain east of it. The Spirit lifted me up and brought me to the exiles in Babylonia in the vision given by the Spirit of God. Then the vision I had seen went up from me, and I told the exiles everything the LORD had shown me.
