


3. Godiness is God restoring the image.

Romans 8:29

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness [image] of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.



Colossians 3:8 – 10

But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Ephesians 4:22 – 24

You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

4. Jesus is the nerfect image of God and embodiment of man.

THE PERFECT IMAGE OF GOD Jesus is God perfectly revealed in flesh.

Philippians 2:5 – 7

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

Hebrews 1:3

The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.



THE PERFECT IMAGE OF MAN Jesus is perfect humanity in being and bearing.

Philippians 2:5 – 7

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

3 PURPOSES OF LIKENESS:

- 1. Makes the incarnation possible
- 2. Makes Jesus truly human
- 3. Makes Jesus capable of being a sacrifice for human sin



Romans 8:1 - 4

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death...

Romans 8:1 - 4

For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in sinful man, in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
