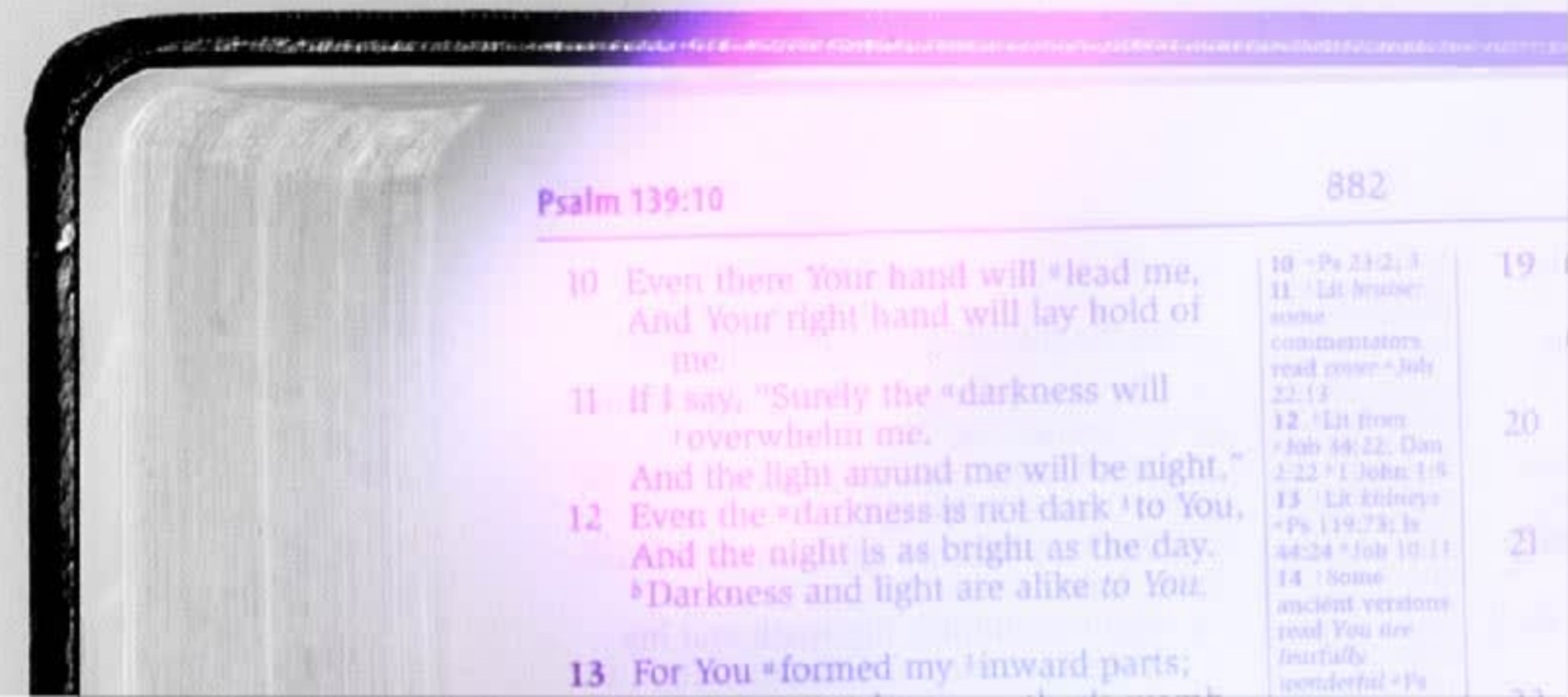

# **AN OVERVIEW OF ROMANS 1 - 7**

**Romans 1: Moral confusion.**

**Romans 2: Moral weakness.**

**Romans 3: Sin in the body ... but Jesus.**

**Romans 4: Faithfulness pleases God, and the Law says so.**

**Romans 5: Adam = Death, Jesus = Life.**

**Romans 6: Christians should live free from sin like Jesus did.**

**Romans 7: If I've still got sin in my flesh, how do I live like Jesus?**



**8:1 – 4: Because Jesus dealt with sin, we can live lives of righteousness and please God.**

**8:5 – 8: Those who EXIST according to the Spirit fulfill the Law of love.**

**8:9 – 13: If the Spirit of Jesus is in you, and the Spirit raised Jesus's body from death to life, the Spirit is giving your dead body the power to conquer sin.**

**8:14 – 17: Because we have the Spirit of Christ, we are God's children just like Jesus is God's son.**

**8:18 – 23: Because we have the Spirit, we will rule the renewed creation with Jesus.**
