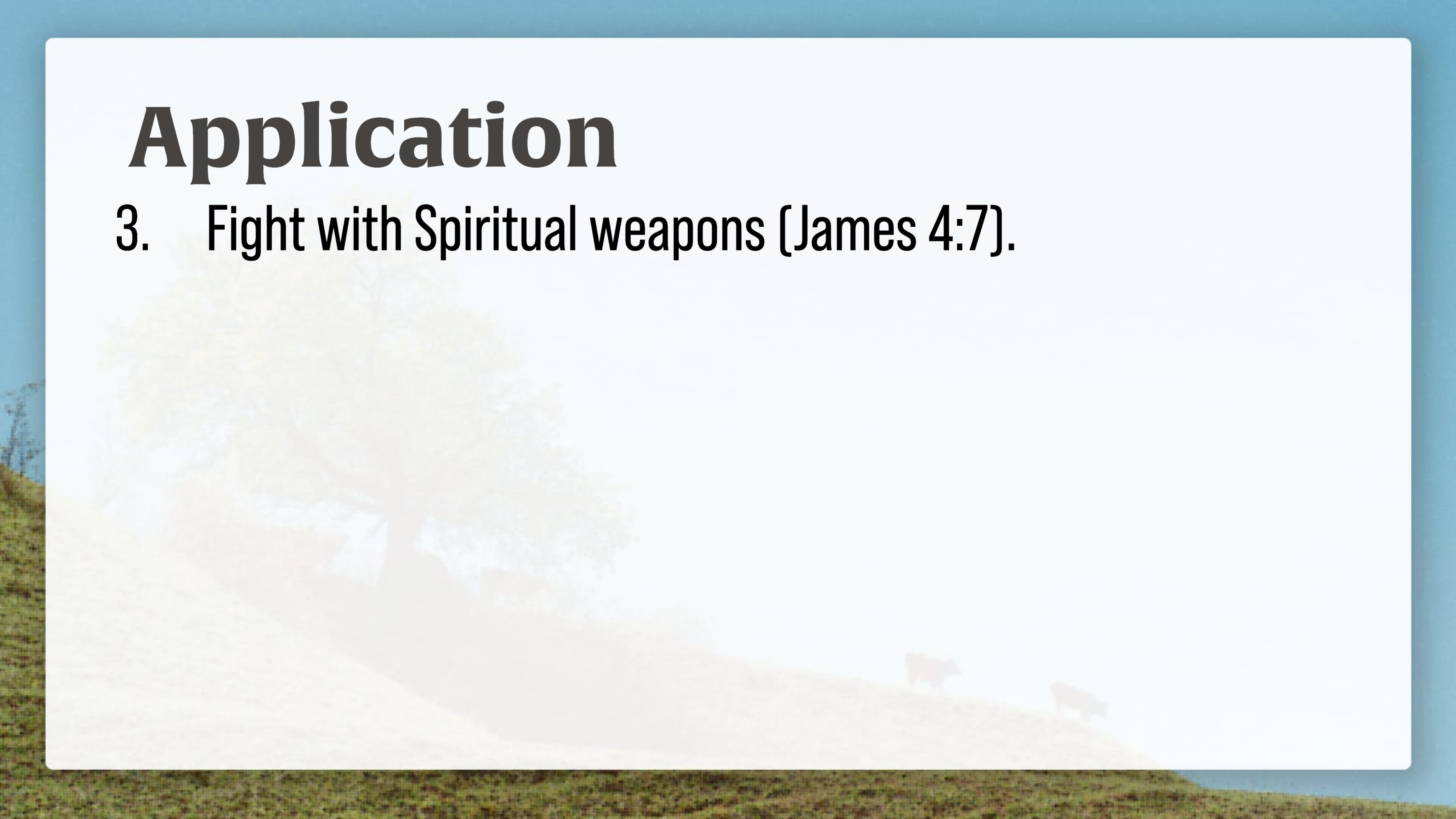
2. Use the FULL Armor of God (Ephesians 6:13 – 17).
