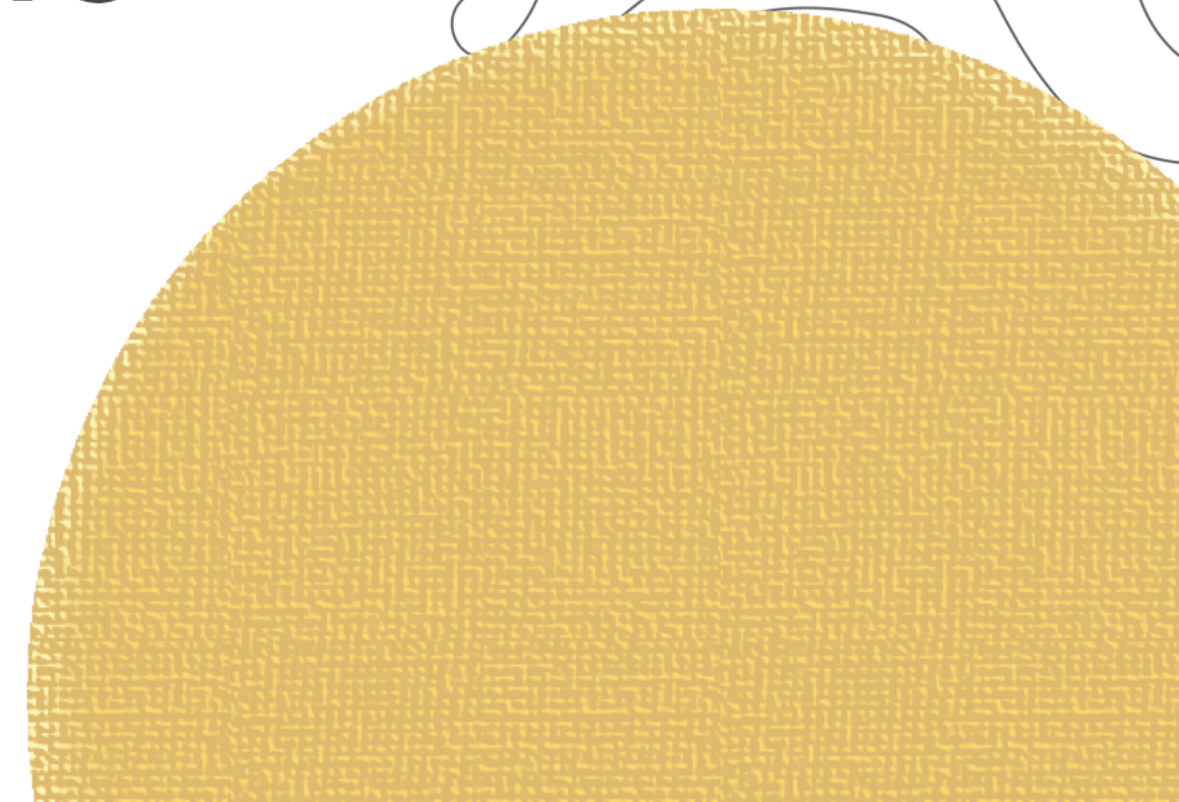
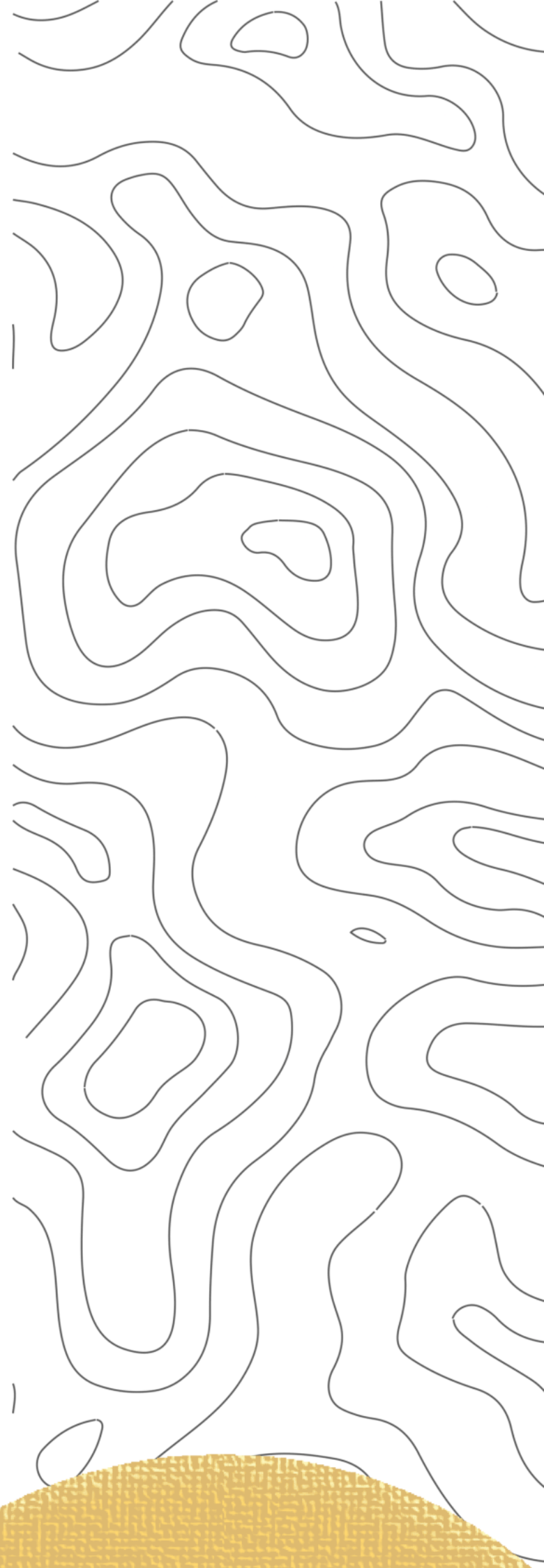
Temple and River

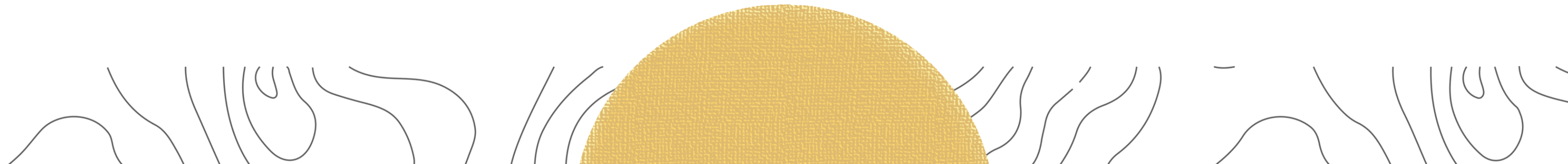
Fish and Fishermen

"You are the salt of the earth"

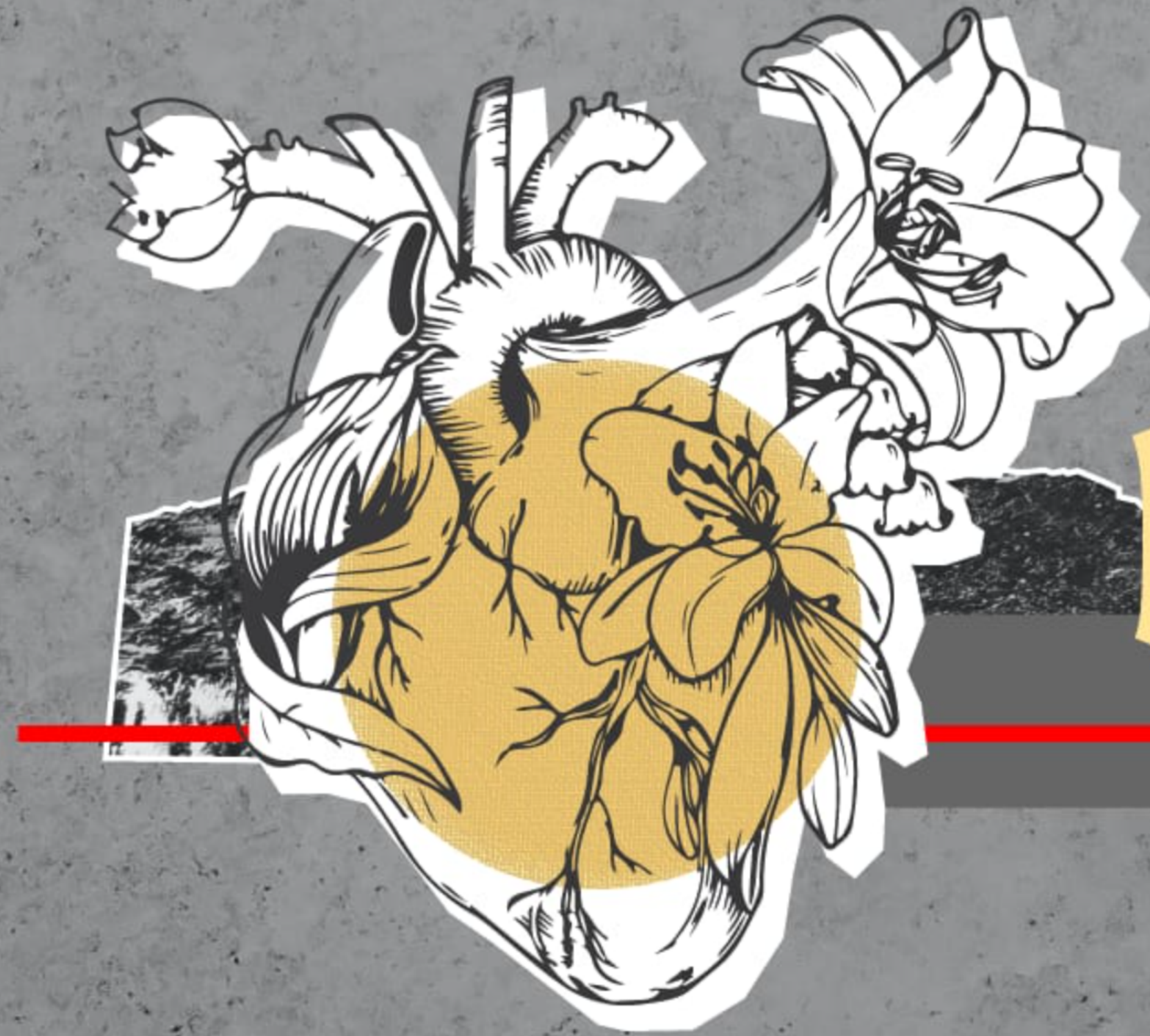
