




# Can human beings live a life of love in the midst of every threat that motivates our fears?

## What to do with fear?

- Medicalize it
- Technologically neutralize
- Remove the threat
- Exercise our need for security
- Find a deeper grounding

#### Psalm 63:1 – 11

O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water. I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory. Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands...

#### Psalm 63:1 - 11








## What is my life for?

### Negative fruit:

Destruction of love, social pleasures, concord, peace, spiritual fellowship, trust, productivity....

## Justification


The right to be counted as a legitimate person who need feel no shame, and has every right and dignity of being a person.
