Rebellion brings blindness. Only God brings sight.

Prov 20:12 "Ears that hear and eyes that see—the LORD has made them both."

Jeremiah 5:20-22

"Announce this to the house of Jacob and proclaim it in Judah: 21 Hear this, you foolish and senseless people, who have eyes but do not see, who have ears but do not hear: 22 Should you not fear me?" declares the LORD. "Should you not tremble in my presence?"

4 kinds of rebellion-induced blindness

1. Blind and deaf to coming slavery

Ezekiel 12:11-13 Say to them, 'I am a sign to you.' "As I have done, so it will be done to them. They will go into exile as captives.

2. Blind and deaf to coming anxiety

Ezekiel 12:19

Say to the people of the land: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says about those living in Jerusalem and in the land of Israel: They will eat their food in anxiety and drink their water in despair, for their land will be stripped of everything in it because of the violence of all who live there.

3. Blind and deaf to flattering lies

Ezekiel 12:23-25

Say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am going to put an end to this proverb, and they will no longer quote it in Israel.' Say to them, 'The days are near when every vision will be fulfilled. 24 For there will be no more false visions or flattering divinations among the people of Israel...


...But I the LORD will speak what I will, and it shall be fulfilled without delay. For in your days, you rebellious house, I will fulfill whatever I say, declares the Sovereign LORD."

4. Blind and deaf to the need for urgency

Ezekiel 12:27-28

"Son of man, the house of Israel is saying, 'The vision he sees is for many years from now, and he prophesies about the distant future.' 28 "Therefore say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: None of my words will be delayed any longer; whatever I say will be fulfilled, declares the Sovereign LORD.'"

Result: Hardened blindness



10 Direct Predictions:

10 Direct Predictions:


- 9. His people will be disbursed

Result: Hardened blindness

2 Kings 25




Isaiah 6:9-10 'Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.' 10 Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed."



Matthew 13:13-17 In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: "'You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. 15 For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes.

Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and l would heal them." 16 But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear.
