



God's character is our foundational comfort

When all our materialist dreams fail, our vision of God's character is our foundational comfort.

(as it should always have been)

God's comforting characterin 3 materialist affictions

1. God's goodness is more solid than human goodness

Ezekiel 14:22-23


...You will be consoled when you see their conduct and their actions, for you will know that I have done nothing in it without cause, declares the Sovereign LORD."

- 2. That's easier to defend if everyone is

basically a good person.

2 key truths:

Those who believe in human goodness will not see or appreciate God's goodness

Those that refuse to see their depravity cannot find their moral gravity.

2. God's rule is more stable than the world's order

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"Nothing without cause"

Though God changes the situation, he is the stable actor.

1 Samuel 15:27–29, James 1:13–18



Our world is pretty stable...

(But even now it still feels unstable)

It's good to enjoy the world's stability, but it is deadly to hope in and be comforted by it.

See: 1 Corinthians 7:29–31

3. God is still redeeming when we are done with dreaming.

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God wants his people to be comforted in his redeeming work at the very moment he completely and permanently destroys their worldly dreams

(Circumstantial vs. Necessary)

Operating assumption:

Assume God will operate as though your personal redemption is 50,000X more important to him than your material or worldly dreams.
