## Bless is a new approach to prayer and evangelism.

It's less about downloading information, and more about loving our neighbors well. These missional practices can help us get "unstuck" and find new ways to share the gospel story. BLESS is an intentional pathway for people of all ages to become like Jesus and join His mission.

This journal is a resource for your BLESS journey with prompts for each practice. These prompts will help you see new opportunities to join the Spirit in blessing people in your life who do not know God.



# How do | BLESS someone in my life?



#### BEGIN WITH PRAYER

Ask God to show you two to three people in your life who do not know God, and pray for them each day.



#### LISTEN WITH CARE

Pay attention to people's dreams and pain. Listen for evidence of God's work in their lives.



#### **EAT TOGETHER**

Share meals together.



#### SERVE IN LOVE

Be attentive to opportunities God provides you to care for people and attend to their needs.



#### SHARE THE STORY

Once you build a relationship and earn trust, look for ways you can share the story of how Jesus is transforming your life and the world.

#### TRACK YOUR PROGRESS

Use the pages throughout this journal to help you on your BLESS journey.

## Eat Together

Share meals with people in your life who do not have a relationship with God. Engage in meaningful conversation.

NATURAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR CONNECTION:

Whether you are eating a meal together or just hanging out, the idea behind this practice is to intentionally spend time together, connecting on a deeper level and building relationship with people who do not know God.

### Possible Ideas

- Have dinner together in your home or at a restaurant.
- Share a pizza.
- Enjoy a cup of coffee together.
- Host a holiday party.
- Organize a block party or neighborhood BBQ.
- Include others in your family celebrations.
- Try new restaurants together.
- Add one person to one meal per week.
- Throw a small dinner party.
- Create an affinity group.
- Teach someone how to cook.
- Attend a party of theirs or throw one together.

You may choose to serve others. However, sometimes the greatest opportunities come when you allow others to serve you.


#### WAYS / CAN ACCEPT SERVICE FROM OTHERS


# Ideas for Sharing the Story of God's Love:

## Share the Story The Story of God's Love

#### A GOSPEL PRESENTATION

### God is love and created the world for love—this includes you and me.

"Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. His love endures forever!"

— PSALM 136:1

God loves us lavishly and created us to enjoy a perfect loving relationship with God, with each other, and with all creation. This was God's intention from the very beginning.

In what ways have you experienced the love of God?

## THE WORLD IS BROKEN BECAUSE OF OUR SIN, WHICH SEPARATES US FROM GOD AND LEADS TO SUFFERING AND DEATH.

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." — ROMANS 3:23

"The wages of sin is death."

— ROMANS 6:23

We sin when we do not act with love toward God or others, whether in active rebellion or passive indifference. Sin leads to death and eternal separation from God. Humanity cannot save itself from the persistent reality of sin and death.

In what ways have you experienced brokenness in the world or in yourself?

#### GOD LOVES THE WORLD AND SENT JESUS TO HEAL OUR BROKENNESS THROUGH HIS LIFE, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." — JOHN 3:16

"God demonstrates his own love toward us in this: While we were still

sinners. Christ died for us." – ROMANS 5:8

"Christ died for our sins....He was buried... he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures...he appeared to Cephas, and then to the twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred."

- 1 CORINTHIANS 15:3-6

God sent his son Jesus not only to show us the way, but also to provide the way. After living a sinless life of perfect love, Jesus bore our sins upon himself and sacrificed his life for us on the cross (1 Peter 2:24 – 25). We cannot be saved through our good works. Through Christ alone we can experience healing, restored relationship with God and others, and full life now and forever.

#### GOD INVITES US TO TURN FROM OUR SIN, RECEIVE GOD'S LOVE, AND THEN SHARE THAT LOVE WITH THE WORLD!

God extends a free invitation to each one of us to receive God's love, enjoy God's love, and join God's mission to heal the world.

## Walking with Them if They Choose Jesus

#### 1. BE EXCITED WITH THEM & FOR THEM

#### 2. DO THESE THINGS FOR THEM:

- Read the Bible with them and talk about it.
   Start in John, then Acts or Philippians.
- Pray with them and talk about prayer.
- Invite them to your small group or church services.
- Introduce them to people they can connect with.
- Talk about God's love, forgiveness, grace, temptation, handling difficult times, and the Holy Spirit.
- Encourage them to tell their experience to their friends and family.

You can pick up two copies of *Knowing Christ* by Mark Jones (one for you and one for them) as a guide. Ask at the High Point Church front desk before or after services.
