



Steward



the quality of the rest of your stewardship comes from your character.






5 things:

- 5. Mental health- stress, self-medication and self-destruction


3. Time (discresionary)




Time use strategies:

- 7. Revisit every couple months




8. Productivity: Work and education

9. The Body of Christ


- 1. A new "nation"- a huge family team

 - 3. Making a contribution






10. Resources and wealth
