
Inquiring of God

If God loves us, he would want us to make the right decision and know what to do.


Therefore, he should speak to us.

2 Key moments:

High Conversion Moments



"Could go either way" Moments.



Decision Fallacy:

Making the right decision (clarvoyance) is more important than making the right kind of decision (wisdom) and making that into the right decision (godliness) and trusting God to work that decision for good (faith).

Decision Fallacy:

Making the right decision (clairvoyance) is more important than making the right kind of decision (faith) and making that into the right decision (love) and trusting God to work that decision for good (hope).

Example: marriage

"Nearly all marriages, even happy ones, are mistakes: in the sense that almost certainly (in a more perfect

world, or even with a little more care in this very imperfect one) both partners might be found more suitable mates. But the real soul-mate is the one you are actually married to."

God's Dilemma:

How does God respond to people wanting his <u>predictions</u> but who refuse his <u>directions</u>?

Ezekiel 14:4-6

Therefore speak to them and tell them, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: When any Israelite sets up idols in his heart and puts a wicked stumbling block before his face and then goes to a prophet...

Ezekiel 14:4-6

... I the LORD will answer him myself in keeping with his great idolatry. I will do this to recapture the hearts of the people of Israel, who have all deserted me for their idols.'

Ezekiel 14:4-6

...Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Repent!

Turn from your idols and renounce all your detestable practices!'



Prophesy includes both Revealed Will and Secret Will, but usually the focus is on returning to obedience with God's Revealed Will.



3 obstacles that need tearing down

1. He must confront the idos metallist

Ezekiel 14:4

...When any Israelite sets up idols in his heart and puts a wicked stumbling block before his face and then goes to a prophet, I the LORD will answer him myself in keeping with his great idolatry.

Before your face:

Behind your back:

...by lying to my people, who listen to lies, you have killed those who should not have died and have spared those who should not live.
