




## Means of Grace



Something freely given on the basis of favor without deserving or right

**Means of Grace:** Channels God normally uses to give us gracious help in forming His character and will in us.

## 3 main means:



- 1. Hearing his voice
- 2. Having his ear
- 3. Belonging to his people
