1 John 3:14 - *We know* that we have passed from death to life, because we love our brothers. Anyone who does not love remains in death.

1 John 3:15-20 - Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth. This then is how we know that we belong to the truth, and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence whenever our hearts condemn us.

1 John 3:24 - Those who obey his commands live in him, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us: *We know* it by the Spirit he gave us.

1 John 4:13 - *We know* that we live in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit.

But how do I know if I have God's Spirit?

Insecurity - What if I can't feel it or know what it is?

Deception - How do I recognize the Spirit in others?

1 John 4:12

No one has ever seen God



1 John 4:1 ...do not believe every spirit...because many false prophets have gone out...

2. The Spirit is recognizable by His spirit.

(This requires discernment.)



The Holy Spirit's identity and presence are authenticated by His *spirit*.

Just like a person's persona:
It isn't their being, but it reveals their being.

Their persona = character, culture, values, emotion, purpose, desire, etc.

Tests for real faith

Characteristics of the Spirit's spirit.
They all tie back to Jesus.

1. Confesses Jesus
2. Obeys God's commands
3. Loves Christian brothers and sisters

The Spirit's spirit and the Word's word (Jesus' actions and commands) are in perfect unity.

Testing anyone's "Spirit":
(yours or another's)

1. Does this Spirit's spirit confess Jesus as He is?
2. Does this Spirit's spirit do what is right according to Jesus?
3. Does this spirit love Jesus in people? Does it love real Christians? Or is it like Cain - full of hatred towards real children of God?

Tests for real faith
