'Victory and blessing as far as the eye can see'

THIS IS WHAT WE WANT WHETHER WE ADMIT IT OR NOT



OF WINNING

IRRELIGION:

'If God wanted people to believe in him, he'd make himself a lot more obvious.'



DISCOURAGED FAITH:

'God could really reveal himself more, especially when pain and discouragement hit. I feel abandoned.'



OF WINNING

MISGUIDED BRANDING

God does reveal himself generously to those who beleive.

"GLORY NOW" BRANDING

Dominionist – revealed rule

The Prosperity Gospel – revealed wealth

Faith Healing – revealed healing

(Half-truths can be the most destructive, because we can lose both by believing the lie, or by being tempted to reject the truth.)

SHROUDED GLORY DOESN'T BRAND



God defies reduction – he forces us to expand into maturity

God confounds worldly tastes – he heals and transforms our tastes.

THIS IS GOOD NEWS.

GOD'S SHROUDED GLORY IS ITSELF A REVELATION.

GOD MAKES HIS GOODNESS THE MEANS OF HIS GLORY

FOLLOW THE LOGIC OF HIS REVELATION

His revelation strategy includes the nature and condition of human beings.

OVER-SIMPLIFIED TO 4 STEPS

STEP: REVELATOR VS. SUPPRESSORS Will the real glory shrouders please stand up?

STEP I: REVELATION VS. SUPPRESSION

God's glory is very revealed (Psalm 19)



VS.

Humans are revelation supressors

(Romans 1:16, John 3:19)



STEP 2: HEALING GLORY


STEP 2: HEALING GLORY

Power has a bad transformation track record

God presses his goodness (Exodus 33:19)
VS.

Humans are addicted to and corrupted by power and glory (entire OT and history)

LUKE 16: RICH MAN AND LAZARUS



verse 30 "...they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead."

PROBLEMS WITH POWER

Those that come to God for power come for all the wrong reasons and are transformed in all the wrong ways. It will make us devils, not saints. This is not God's eternal purpose.

PROBLEMS WITH POWER

- 1. Motivates repulsive, lopsided faith
- 2. Power corrupts us in this condition
- 3. We need the school of humility

Power grows the cancer of indwelling sin in us rather than strengthening the immune system of human nature

STEP 3: GRACE

God acts to fit us for glory freely

VS.

Humans seek to trade and sacrifice for power



Idolatry and legalism have the same roots (Romans 1&2)

EXAMPLE: 'BREAD OF LIFE'

John 6:26 - 29

Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, you are looking for me, not because you saw miraculous signs but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you.

STEP 4: CONFRONTATION

God offers a savior who presses God's purposes

VS.

Humans angered by the promise of glory through humility and suffering.

John 14:22 - 29

Then Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said, "But, Lord, why do you intend to show yourself to us and not to the world?" Jesus replied, "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. He who does not love me will not obey my teaching...

John 14:22 - 29

...These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me. "All this I have spoken while still with you. But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives...

John 14:22 - 29

...Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. "You heard me say, 'I am going away and I am coming back to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. I have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe."
