

- 1. **Believe Jesus is the Christ** 5:1-5 (Also 3:23, 4:2, 4:9, 5:1)
- 2. Loving your brother (other Christians) including generosity 3:11-20
- 3. Obeying God's commandments 2:3-6
- 4. Experience Spirit's anointing 2:20-23, 4:13
- 5. Do not love the world 2:15
- 6. **Stop walking in sin /** stop sinning (sins of presumption) 3:6
- 7. Remain, overcome and persevere 2:19, 24-25, 2:13, 14, 5:4







Confidence to pray for ourselves spiritually

1 John 5:14-15

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us - whatever we ask - we know that we have what we asked of him.

Confidence to pray for straying believers

1 John 5:16-18

If anyone sees his brother commit a sin that does not lead to death, he should pray and God will give him life. I refer to those whose sin does not lead to death. There is a sin that leads to death. I am not saying that he should pray about that. All wrongdoing is sin, and there is sin that does not lead to death. 18 We know that anyone born of God does not continue to sin; the one who was born of God keeps him safe, and the evil one cannot harm him.
