



Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger,

brawling and slander, **along with every form of malice**. Be kind and compassionate to one

another, <u>forgiving each other</u>, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Like fear and pride, bitterness is a

"denial condition."

We deny we have it because it is a humiliatingly unsophisticated condition.

So we imagine it isn't there — though it's obvious in everyone else.



Bitterness: How does it work? Why is it so poisonous?

Hebrews 12:15

See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no **bitter root grows up** to cause trouble and defile many.



Root plant: Everything needed to grow is stored in the root. It's just waiting for the right moment to sprout up.
